THIS AGREEMENT, made this day of One Thousand
Nine Hundred and Eighty-two, between the COUNTY OF BURLINGTON acting through its
BOARD OF CHOSEN FREEHOLDERS OF THE COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, hereinafter referred to
as the County, and the STATE OF NEW JERSEY, acting through its Commissioner of
Transportation, hereinafter referred to as the State, witnesseth that:

WHEREAS, the State will cause the construction of a new bridge and approaches over the Rancocas Creek; and

WHEREAS, this construction will cause Route U.S. 130 and Bridgeboro Street to be relocated; and

WHEREAS, Bridgeboro Street is Burlington County Route 537 SPUR; and WHEREAS, it is necessary that the County and the State apportion the jurisdiction for highway maintenance and control of these improved facilities in an equitable manner pursuant to N.J.S.A. 27:7-1 et seq.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, the County and the State agree as follows:

FIRST, the County agrees to:

- (a) Upon completion of construction assume or retain jurisdiction for highway maintenance and control in those areas as shown with solid single line hatching on a map entitled "NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, ROUTE U.S. 130, SECTION 9F, JURISDICTIONAL LIMIT MAP, RELOCATED BRIDGEBORO STREET, TOWNSHIPS OF WILLINGBORO, DELANCO AND DELRAN, COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, SCALE: 1" = 200', DATE: JUNE, 1982," which map is appended hereto and made a part hereof.
- (b) Upon completion of construction assume or retain jurisdiction for highway maintenance in that area as shown with broken single line hatching on above map.

SECOND, the State agrees to:

- (a) Upon completion of construction assume jurisdiction for highway maintenance and control in those areas as shown shaded (not distinguished in any other manner) on said map.
- (b). Upon completion of construction assume or retain jurisdiction for highway control in that area as shown with broken single line hatching on said map.

THIRD, both the County and the State agree that:

- (a) Nothing contained in this agreement shall be construed to affect the legal and/or maintenance responsibilities for any traffic signal systems, overhead lighting, or other electrical facilities involved in the subject roadway areas.
- (b) This agreement will not be binding until executed by the Commissioner of Transportation or his designee.
