One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Five, between the COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, acting through its BOARD OF CHOSEN FREEHOLDERS, hereinafter referred to as the County, and the STATE OF NEW JERSEY, acting through its Commissioner of Transportation, hereinafter referred to as the State, witnesseth that:

WHEREAS, the State Highway Commission on January 3, 1929 adopted a resolution whereby Route 39 (now Route 170 & Route 206) was taken over from Burlington County; and

WHEREAS, the State by-passed a portion of Route 39 through Columbus thereby creating Route 206 at its present location; and

WHEREAS, the State then redesignated this by-passed section as Route 170; and

WHEREAS, Route 170 ceased being an integral part of the State's highway system; and

WHEREAS, Burlington County has agreed to reassume jurisdiction of Route 170 in Mansfield Township; and

WHEREAS, to lessen the initial maintenance burden on the County the State will resurface Route 170 and make certain improvements as requested by the County; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that the County and the State apportion the jurisdiction for highway maintenance and control for Route 170 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 27:7-1 et seq., in an equitable manner.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, the County and the State agree as follows:

FIRST, the County agrees to:

Upon completion of the State's improvements to Route 170 reassume or retain the jurisdiction for highway maintenance and control in those areas as shown with single line hatching on a map entitled "NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, ROUTE 170, JURISDICTIONAL LIMIT MAP, JURISDICTIONAL TRANSFER, TOWNSHIP OF MANSFIELD, COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, SCALE: AS INDICATED, APRIL, 1985," which map is appended hereto and made a part hereof.

SECOND, the State agrees to:

- Assume or retain the jurisdiction for highway maintenance and control in those areas shown shaded on the said map.
- Resurface Route 170 to the limits as delineated on said map.
- Stabilize or provide stabilization to approximately 1,250 feet (c) of existing shoulder on the northerly end of Route 170.
- (d) Provide for the protection of slope erosion of an existing concrete culvert on the northerly end of Route 170.

THIRD, both the County and the State agree that:

- (a) A separate agreement will be executed whereby the legal and/or maintenance responsibilities for the existing traffic signal system at Route 170 and W. Main Street will be apportioned.
- This agreement will not be binding until executed by the Commissioner of Transportation or his designee.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties have signed, sealed and attested to this agreement.
