

THIS AGREEMENT, made this day of , One Thousand, Nine Hundred Seventy-five, between the COUNTY OF BURLINGTON acting through its BOARD OF CHOSEN FREEHOLDERS OF THE COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, hereinafter called the County, and the STATE OF NEW JERSEY, acting through its Commissioner of Transportation, hereinafter called the State, witnesseth that:

WHEREAS, the legal and maintenance responsibilities at the intersection of Marter Avenue (County Route 615) and Route 38 have never been officially established; and

WHEREAS, in order to avoid the possibility of any future disagreement between the State and the County concerning these roads, it is necessary that the County and the State apportion the jurisdiction, control, and maintenance of these facilities in an equitable manner.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, the County and the State agree as follows:

FIRST, the County agrees to:

(a) Assume or retain jurisdiction, control and complete responsibility for all maintenance in that area that was improved by the State, as shown with single line hatching on a map entitled "NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, ROUTE 295 SECTION 2J & ROUTE 38 SECTIONS 2D, 3A, JURISDICTIONAL LIMIT MAP, HAROLD, WALTON & MARTER AVENUES, TOWNSHIPS OF MOORESTOWN & MOUNT LAUREL, BURLINGTON COUNTY SCALE: 1" = 200', AUGUST 1975," appended hereto and made a part hereof.

SECOND, the State agrees to:

(a) Assume jurisdiction, control and complete responsibility for all maintenance in those areas shown shaded (not hatched in any manner) on the said map within the right of way of Route 38 and Route 295.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the County has had this instrument signed and attested, and the State has caused the same to be done on its part.
