THIS AGREEMENT, made this // day of
One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety, between the COUNTY OF
BURLINGTON, a body politic and corporate acting through its BOARD OF
CHOSEN FREEHOLDERS, hereinafter referred to as the "County", and the
STATE OF NEW JERSEY, acting through its Commissioner of
Transportation, hereinafter referred to as the "State", witnesseth
that:

WHEREAS, the State has made improvements to Route 295 in the County; and

WHEREAS, these improvements have included the area of Elbo Lane at Route 295; and

WHEREAS, Elbo Lane is a County highway; and

WHEREAS, the jurisdictional limits for highway maintenance and control of these areas have never been established between the County and the State; and

WHEREAS, in order to prevent future legal or maintenance problems in these areas, it is necessary that the County and the State apportion the jurisdiction for highway maintenance and control in an equitable manner pursuant to N.J.S.A. 27:7-1 et seq.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, the County and the State agree as follows:

FIRST, the County agrees to:

Assume or retain jurisdiction for highway maintenance and control in those areas as shown with crosshatching on a map entitled "NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, ROUTE 295 SECTION 2J, JURISDICTIONAL LIMIT MAP, Route 295 AT ELBO LANE, TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT LAUREL, COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, SCALE: AS INDICATED: MARCH 1990," which map is appended hereto and made a part hereof.

SECOND, the State agrees to:

Assume or retain jurisdiction for highway maintenance and control in those areas shown shaded on the said map.

THIRD, both the County and the State agree that:

- Nothing contained in this agreement shall be construed to affect the legal and/or maintenance responsibilities for any traffic signal systems, overhead lighting, or other electrical facilities involved in the subject roadway areas.
- This agreement will not be binding until executed by the Commissioner of Transportation or the Commissioner's designee.
