THIS AGREEMENT, made this

6th

day of December

One Thousand Nine Hundred Sixty-eight between the BOARD OF CHOSEN FREEHOLDERS OF THE COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, hereinafter called the County and the STATE OF NEW JERSEY acting through its Commissioner of Transportation, hereinafter called the State;

WHEREAS, in the construction of Route 295 Section 2J, an overpass was built at Mount Laurel Road along with improvements to portions of said Mount Laurel Road; and

WHEREAS, the shoulders on said Mount Laurel Road were constructed of oil penetrated gravel; and

WHEREAS, upon acceptance of this agreement by the County, the State will construct bituminous concrete pavement on the shoulders of said Mount Laurel Road; and

WHEREAS, it is impelling upon the County and the State to apportion the jurisdiction, control and maintenance of these improved facilities in an equitable manner.

NOW, THEREFORE, this agreement witnesseth that for and in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, the County and the State agree as follows:

FIRST, the County agrees to:

Assume or retain jurisdiction, control and maintenance in those areas as shown with crosshatching on a map entitled, "NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, ROUTE 295 SECTION 2J, JURISDICTIONAL LIMIT MAP, MOUNT LAUREL ROAD, MOORESTOWN TOWNSHIP, BURLINGTON COUNTY, SCALE: 1"=50', DECEMBER 1967."

SECOND, the State agrees to:

Assume jurisdiction, control and maintenance in those areas shown plain (not hatched nor shaded in any manner) on the said map with the right of way Route 295.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the County has had this instrument signed, had it attested, and the State has caused the same to be done on its part.
