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THIS AGREEMENT, made this 6th day of December One Thousand
Nine Hundred Sixty-eight between the BOARD OF CHOSEN FREEHOLDERS OF THE COUNTY
OF BURLINGTON, hereinafter called the County and the STATE OF NEW JERSEY acting
through its Commissioner of Transportation, hereinafter called the State;

WHEREAS, in the construction of Route 295 Section 4B the State plans to build a bridge to carry Burlington-Columbus Road over Route 295 so as to conform to Interstate Standards; and

WHEREAS, the construction will entail improvement to portions of Burlington-Columbus Road; and

WHEREAS, the jurisdiction, control and maintenance of these improved facilities is of vital concern to the County.

NOW, THEREFORE, this agreement witnesseth that for and in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, the County and the State agree as follows:

FIRST, the County agrees to:

- (a) Assume jurisdiction and control in those areas to be improved as shown with single line hatching on a map entitled: "NEW JERSEY DEPT. OF TRANSPORTATION, ROUTE 295 SECT. LAB, JURISDICTIONAL LIMIT MAP, ROUTE 295 AND RELOCATED JACKSONVILLE RD. AND BURLINGTON-COLUMBUS ROAD, FLORENCE TOWNSHIP, MANFIELD TOWNSHIP, BURLINGTON COUNTY, SCALE: 1" = 100', FEBRUARY 1967".
- (b) Perform minor maintenance functions in those areas specified in (a) above for a period of five years from date of completion of said improvement after which time the County will perform complete maintenance functions.
- (c) Perform ice control and snow removal functions in those areas specified in (a) above and that area of Burlington-Columbus Road that is bridged over Route 295 shown plain (not hatched nor shaded in any manner).
- (d) Notify the State of any major maintenance obviously needed in those areas specified in (a) above prior to the end of the said five year period.

SECOND, the State agrees to:

- (a) Assume jurisdiction, control and maintenance in those areas shown plain (not hatched nor shaded in any manner) on the said map within the right of way of Route 295.
- (b) Perform major maintenance functions in those areas specified in part FIRST item (a) either on its own initiative or upon notice from the County until the end of said five year period; after which date all maintenance will be performed by the County.

(c) Perform complete structural maintenance of said bridge.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the County has had this instrument signed, had it attested, and the State has caused the same to be done on its part.
