THIS AGREEMENT, made this day of

One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-nine, between the COUNTY OF

BURLINGTON, acting through its BOARD OF CHOSEN FREEHOLDERS, hereinafter

referred to as the "County", and the STATE OF NEW JERSEY, acting through

its Commissioner of Transportation, hereinafter referred to as the

"State", witnesseth that:

WHEREAS, improvements are being made to a portion of State Highway Route 38 in the "County"; and

WHEREAS, these improvements will include several "County" highways; and

WHEREAS, the jurisdictional limits for highway maintenance and control of these intersections have never been established between the "County" and the "State"; and

WHEREAS, in order to prevent future legal or maintenance problems in these areas, it is necessary that the "County" and the "State" apportion the jurisdiction for highway maintenance and control in an equitable manner pursuant to N.J.S.A. 27:7-1 et seq.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, the "County" and the "State" agree as follows:

FIRST, the "County" agrees to:

Assume or retain jurisdiction for highway maintenance and control, upon completion of construction, in those areas as shown with single line hatching on sheets 1 and 2 of 2 total sheets of a map entitled "NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, ROUTE 38 (1953) SECTION 3B, JURISDICTIONAL LIMIT MAP, FROM EAST OF THE NEW JERSEY TURNPIKE TO EAST OF CREEK ROAD, TOWNSHIPS OF MOUNT LAUREL AND HAINESPORT, COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, SCALE; AS INDICATED, MAY 1987," which map is appended hereto and made a part hereof.

SECOND, the "State" agrees to:
Assume or retain jurisdiction for highway maintenance and control, upon

completion of construction, in those areas shown dotted on the said map.

THIRD, both the "County" and the "State" agree that:

(a) Nothing contained in this agreement shall be construed to affect the legal and/or maintenance responsibilities for any traffic signal systems, overhead lighting, or other electrical facilities involved in the subject roadway areas.

This agreement will not be binding until executed by the Commissioner of Transportation or the Commissioner's designee.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties have signed, sealed and attested to this agreement.
